

Though Alban Berg's *Violin Concerto* was conceived and initiated to satisfy a commission from the American violinist Louis Krasner, it soon turned into a monument to a departed loved one. The death of Alma Mahler's daughter, Manon Gropius, at the tender age of 18 led Berg to finish the work quickly, taking a requiem as his model. But it also foreshadowed his own death shortly thereafter: by the time of its première in 1936 he had already passed away.

The Berg Violin Concerto, with its advanced handling of atonality and the 12-note method, is one of the supreme creations of modern music, a vivid confrontation with the subject of death. Now this seminal work of its era is being made available in an entirely new way, with a bilingual commentary in German and English. A must for every lover of fine music!
